Scattered mature eucalypts lend a sense of permanence to the fertile alluvial soils and lush river flats.

Two clean watercourses-the Inman River and Back Valley Creek-either border or cross the property, creating vibrant riparian zones rich in native vegetation. These areas have been enhanced by conservation plantings, supporting biodiversity and providing habitat for local wildlife.

A standout feature is the substantial shed infrastructure-ideal for those who value a practical space to relax, work, or pursue hobbies. It includes a lunchroom/kitchen, toilet, and a comfortable rest area, all serviced by mains power and hot and cold running water from a rainwater tank. It's a versatile retreat for weekend visits, project work, or simply enjoying the quiet of the countryside.

The property also includes steel cattle yards and a hay shed-functional additions that support its use as a small farm or lifestyle holding. Whether you're running a few cattle, storing feed, or enjoying the authenticity of a rural escape, these features add value and practicality.

Water is pumped from the Inman River, which in living memory has never run dry-even during extended dry spells-providing a reliable supply.














Lunch Shed
