108 Pooles Rd 36.42ha/ 90 acres

- 50/50 balance of higher country and fertile flats
- Stock water is supplied via windmill to poly tank, feeding out to all four paddocks on this parcel of land,
- 3 Bay open machinery shed + rainwater tanks
- Portable galv steel cattle yards in excellent condition with crush & loading ramp, holding facilities for 50 Head\*
- 2x shipping containers included in the sale

- No structural improvements on this parcel of land
- This parcel consists of strong black, fertile flats
- Excellent fertiliser history, consisting of 100kg per HA of MAP annually in addition to hay booster on some paddocks.
- Stock water is supplied via a near-new solar powered pump, which delivers water to a poly storage tank before being reticulated to concrete troughs throughout the property

- No structural improvements on this parcel of land

Pastures across the whole of the property predominantly consist of diverse mix of chicory, perennial ryegrass, sub clover, strawberry clover, phalaris and a selection of native grasses.
