Perched at the southern end of the Kanimbla Valley, "Gibraltar" is approximately ½ hour's drive from Little Hartley and 2 hours from Parramatta and only minutes from the beautiful Coffs River. The property has a large, well-constructed dam and is benefitted with a reliable spring. An excellent set of steel cattle yards, with crush and concrete race has been erected in a well-located position, with sound truck access. While the block would make an ideal weekender, it is productive enough to provide an income from livestock. An all-weather, gravel road provides access to the elevated, cleared area revealing many potential house-sites, close to power, water and expansive views.
