- Water is a feature! â#l. Eight* dams, two bores, and Tuglow River, Boggy swamp Creek and Dunns Creek running through the property.
- Troughs provide fresh water for livestock.
- Set in high capacity undulating breeding, grazing, and finishing country with solid fertilizer history and excellent pasture management.
- Topography runs from soft and level alluvial flats to heavier undulating slopes.
- All of the property has been pasture improved, with excellent pastures over the property consisting phalaris, rye grass, clovers and cox foot. Clean country with minimal weeds.
- Pastures have been consistently fertilised with NPS blend.
- Subdivided into 16*main paddocks with a central laneway system. All of the boundary and internal fencing all in very good stock proof condition and includes some electrified.
- Climate Sitting at approximately 1130ASL to 1180m ASL the property enjoys a temperate climate, 36inch rainfall average with cool winters and mild summers, making it ideal for pasture growth.
- 18m x 6m three stand colorbond woolshed with attached yard, internal toilet, and 22,700 litre water tank.
- Extensive timber and steel cattle yards with undercover mounted vet crush, elevated steel walkway. All weather access.
- 24*m x 12*m machinery shed with concrete floor and two open 6*m wide bays and two elevated 22,500 litre water tanks.
- An adjoining 13*m x 12*m shed is currently used as a machinery shed and as a lockable chemical store .
- For extra fodder storage 2 x 50 tonne cone bottom silos located on a concrete slab for ease of access.
- 12 metre X 18 metre hayshed. Will accommodate round bales stacked to 4 high.
